



LifeMed Alaska strives to provide patients with the safest and highest quality air medical transportation. Larger patients can be especially challenging in small aircraft, where space and weight capacity are limited. We are usually able to transport large patients, but extra information is needed to determine if additional resources are needed.

Please complete and fax this form for all patients that exceed ANY of these parameters:

- 300 pounds weight,
- 28 inches width (at widest point, shoulders or hips), or
- 6' 6" (78 inches) in height.

Exceeding these parameters does not mean that LifeMed won't be able to transport your patient—it simply means that extra information is required to determine the safest mode of transport for your patient and our crew. Providing this information helps to ensure we can mount the timeliest response possible.
